Keynote | DR. HÉCTOR M. **RODRÍGUEZ** was born in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He has been teaching law, theology, leadership, and ministry at various universities and seminaries for thirty years. Dr. Rodríguez is currently adjunct faculty at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and Spanish Eastern School of Theology. He is a frequent conference speaker in
